

Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg home wins award!

The annual City of Winnipeg Accessibility Awards was held on September 30th at City Hall. The Habitat two-storey home at 924 McCalman Avenue won a Special Recognition Award for its accessible design that adapted the main floor living quarters so Ibsa, a quadriplegic, could have full access from the back deck, through the main floor and to the front deck. His specially designed suite also enables him direct access to a uniquely designed bathroom and shower and other amenities. The rest of the family members have rooms upstairs and in the lowest level. Habitat for Humanity builds homes for families in need and in this case the need was extreme and required a unique and innovative design to fulfill that need. Friesen Tokar Architects partnered with Habitat to design the award-winning home and shares the recognition of this great honour.
