The homes will be built to both the Manitoba Hydro Power Smart Gold Standard and the Green Building Council developed Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED®) Green Building Rating System™. The housing development will be located on the site of the former Sir Sam Steele School and will be HFHW's largest initiative to date.
