Habitat for Humanity Muddy Waters 100 Cycling Event

What: For the first time, Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg (HFHW) is a partner in the Muddy Waters 100 cycling event. This unique event will be the one day per year that the City of Winnipeg closes down a major urban route, with police escort, so that cyclists of all skill levels and ages can ride together in a celebration of cycling and to support a great cause! There are four ride distances -100 miles, 100km, 60km or 25km distances.

When: 9:00 a.m., Sunday, August 9, 2009
Participant check-in begins at 8am – opportunity for interviews at this time.
Riders will be returning back to the Forks throughout the day.
